Gifted Education Portfolio

The tasks outlined in this portfolio are designed to provide the gifted learner with opportunities for personal development and growth. Students are expected to complete a minimum of *500 points worth of tasks per semester* (250 per quarter) and should choose tasks from a variety of categories based on individual need. Students not enrolled in a Quest class can complete a minimum of *300 points per year*, approx. 75 per quarter, to work towards accomplishing IEP related goals.

Students must complete their work at the quality that is expected of a highly intelligent gifted student. This is meaningful work toward your future experiences and plans so you are expected take it seriously and devote the time and effort that it requires.
